The pediatricians in the office also utilize the paradigm of surveillance, screening and referral for children ages birth to 3 years of age for early detection of behavioral, emotional and developmental concerns. Genesis Family Medical Center	Genesis Family Medical Center has provided Shared Medical visits since 2007. Shared Medical is an innovative model to improve care to patients with chronic disease such as diabetes. This model for delivering care is a multi-disciplinary approach, lead by the patients' physician. The same group of patients meets quarterly for an hour and a half. During the group visit, the patient has an exam, a review of their medical care, and a group discussion or an educational presentation about the management of diabetes. CHC is also working on another pilot project that will increase the communication and collaboration with Vera French about the care of mutual patients.
